

AGREEMENT
between
THE AUSTRALIAN INSTITUTE OF PHYSICS and THE PHYSICAL SOCIETY OF
REPUBLIC OF CHINA

To enhance relations and improve communications, the Australian Institute of Physics (AIP) and the Physical Society of Republic of China (PSROC) agree as follows:

1. Scientific Contacts

The AIP and PSROC will encourage scientific contacts between members in their respective countries by exchanging information about their activities, particularly about their educational programs, meetings, conferences and publication activities.

2. Membership Privileges

Members of AIP who are not members of PSROC will be able to:

- 2.1 Submit papers to PSROC meetings on the same terms as PSROC members,
- 2.2 Attend PSROC meetings at member rates,
- 2.3 Subscribe to PSROC journals at the same rates as PSROC members.

Members of PSROC who are not members of AIP will be able to:

- 2.4 Submit papers to AIP meetings on the same terms as JSAP members,
- 2.5 Attend AIP meetings at member rates.

3. Joint AIP and PSROC Endeavors

- 3.1 AIP and PSROC will look for opportunities to organize short courses, joint topical meetings and joint international conferences.
- 3.2 AIP and PSROC will inform each other of current officers and provide contact information.
- 3.3 AIP and PSROC will mail two copies of their publications to other party.

4. Promotion

AIP and PSROC will make reasonable efforts to ensure that these arrangements and privileges are promoted to their members at least once a year, directly or through their respective member journal(s).

5. Proceedings

- 5.1 For PSROC, general inquiries will be handled by Director of International Affairs and contacts between the two parties will be managed by President.
- 5.2 For AIP, general inquiries will be handled by the Secretary. Contacts between the two parties will be managed by President.
- 5.3 AIP and PSROC will ensure that the other party is placed on their mailing list to receive
