

**AGREEMENT FOR RECIPROCAL MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES
BETWEEN THE INSTITUT FIZIK MALAYSIA AND
THE PHYSICAL SOCIETY OF THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

To enhance scientific relations and improve communications between physicists in Malaysia and in the Republic of China, the Institut Fizik Malaysia (IFM) and the Physical Society of the Republic of China (PSROC) agree to extend reciprocal membership privileges as defined below to members of both societies.

- 1) Members of PSROC may submit papers to IFM conferences with the same privileges as IFM members.
- 2) PSROC members may register at IFM conferences at IFM member rate.
- 3) PSROC members may subscribe to IFM journals at the same rate as IFM members.


Conversely,

- 1) Members of IFM may submit papers to PSROC meetings with the same privileges as PSROC members.
- 2) IFM members may register at PSROC conferences at PSROC member rate.
- 3) IFM members may subscribe to PSROC journals at the same rate as PSROC members.


This agreement shall come into immediate effect on signature by both the President of the Institut Fizik Malaysia and the Physical Society of the Republic of China and shall remain in force until either the Institut Fizik Malaysia or the Physical Society of the Republic of China gives 12 months written notice of termination or a wish to renegotiate the agreement.
